Eligibility and Standards

Participation is open to those who exhibit fine art and fine crafts of original concept that they have executed. We strive for quality, and our audience expects it. Use of commercial kits, prefabricated forms, molds, or purchased products is not acceptable. All exhibited work must be represented in pictures or slides. Artists may not share booth space except where there is collaboration in the work shown. Demonstrations are encouraged. The committee reserves the right to refuse an artist whose work does not represent the slides or pictures submitted for jurying or who, in other ways, fails to comply with State requirements.

Fees

- \$ 5 Non-refundable Jury Fee for *each medium being juried*
 - \$160 Outdoor booth on grounds of Farm
 - \$170 Indoor booth in the Stone Barn or other buildings
 - \$ 20 Trailer or additional car (no entry without pass)
 - \$ 10 Late fee when submitted after deadline of March 19, 2010
- Make all checks payable to MCHS.

Jurying Policy

All applicants must enclose four slides or pictures, three of work and one of booth setup, to be evaluated for craftsmanship, originality, and design quality. These slides and pictures will be the only criteria used in selection. It is important that they be clear and in focus. Slides and pictures provided by accepted applicants will be returned to them during the show.

Application Procedure

1. **Complete Attached Form** providing all information requested and Wisconsin Sellers Permit form. The Historical Society must forward the Sellers Permit form to the State for all exhibitors. (Birth date is required for a Greendale vendor permit.)

2. Enclose:

- a. Four (4) slides or pictures (3 of work, 1 of booth setup).
- b. Completed application and Wisconsin Sellers Permit form.
- c. *Separate* \$5 non-refundable check (Jury Fee), for each medium being juried into the show, payable to MCHS.
- d. Booth rental fee and extra vehicle fees made out to MCHS.
- e. Self-addressed stamped envelope that fits your photos/slides and adequate postage.

3. Mail all of the above to:

4. **Application deadline is March 19, 2010. Applications received after this date must pay all fees, including a late fee of \$10.00.**

Additional Information

1. Booth space is 10' x 11' (approximately)
2. All checks are held until March 19, 2010.
3. Notification of acceptance or rejection will be mailed late March.
4. Exhibitors receive all proceeds from sales and are responsible for collecting and reporting all State sales taxes.
5. Setup: Friday from 9 a.m. — 7 p.m. (encouraged); Sat. and Sun. from 7 — 9:30 a.m. Limited security on Friday / Saturday nights.
6. Mini-Raffle Mart: To give exhibitors' work greater exposure and to raise additional funds for Farm restoration, artists are asked to donate an item (tax-deductible) for a raffle, to be prominently displayed with booth number and business card of artist.
7. Request forms for promotional postcards will be included with letters to accepted applicants. Exhibitors also will receive space allocation, directions, and parking passes in mid-summer.
8. We try to accommodate space requests but cannot guarantee them.

The Milwaukee County Historical Society will not assume any liability in the case of loss or damage to work from any cause. Insurance responsibility is left to the artist. Artists will abide by Village of Greendale ordinances and Wisconsin state law including compliance with Fire Department and Village building regulations; will indemnify and hold harmless the Milwaukee County Historical Society, its officers, the Village of Greendale, and the Milwaukee County Department of Parks for any claim or cause of action against those mentioned from acts of exhibitors or anyone else.
