Abstract: The Milwaukee Section, National Council of Jewish Women, was formed in 1895 to help the numerous Jewish immigrants flocking to Milwaukee. The group, however, seemed to flounder for some time until it was reorganized/reactivated on June 1, 1909, with the avowed purpose of promoting fellowship among Jewish women, furthering Judaism through concerted action and carrying out a “platform of common interest along lines of social service, education, peace and civics.”

Scope and Content: The collection consists of meeting minutes, board minutes, financial records and reports, and a brief history of the Milwaukee chapter.
