**Abstract:** The Charles Allis Art Museum was originally the home of Milwaukee-native Charles Allis and his wife Sarah. The family was very active in the community, and Charles was one of the organizers of the Milwaukee Arts Society, and a trustee at the Layton Art Gallery. Upon their deaths, they donated their mansion, filled with unique artwork, to the public. This became the Charles Allis Art Museum officially in 1979.
