- Milwaukee County Division of Emergency Government

Until Jan. 1, 1989 the Milwaukee City and Milwaukee County Civil Defense Divisions were separate, with the City’s traditionally being the stronger unit and possessing more programs. By 1989 the two units were integrated to create a county-wide organization more consistent with like organizations throughout the state of Wisconsin.
