**Abstract:** The City of Milwaukee’s Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) is charged with administering the city’s historic preservation ordinance, which was adopted in 1981. The HPC is responsible for designating both historic landmarks and historic districts in the City of Milwaukee and for approving Certificates of Appropriateness (COAs) to alter historic buildings.

**Scope and Content:** This collection consists of lists and maps of HPC-designated structures and districts from 1988 and 1995, the HPC’s publication *Preservation Topics* No. 1 (1987), correspondence related to a designation and COAs (1989), and a 2025 HPC “Cream of the Cream City Awards” program.
