Abstract: A native of Wisconsin's Door County Peninsula, Professor Tishler completed his graduate work at Harvard University. He undertook additional study at the University of North Carolina, the Nantucket Preservation Planning Institute, Cornell University, and the Attingham Summer Institute in England. He is past president of the Vernacular Architecture Forum, has served on the board of advisors to the National Trust for Historic Preservation, has been chairperson of Wisconsin's Historic Preservation Review Board, and Vice-President for the Arts of the Wisconsin Academy of Sciences, Arts, and Letters.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of a typed lecture notes that accompanied a PowerPoint presentation Professor Tishler delivered to the Friends of Lake Park, Milwaukee Wisconsin on February 28th, 2009.
